Students of Thesis option from each Group will have to take **two courses** from cluster 1 and **two courses** from cluster 2. Students of Non-Thesis option from each Group will have to take **two courses** from cluster 1 and **four courses** from cluster 2.

Students having minimum CGPA of 3.25 at B.A. Honours level are eligible for thesis option. Research topics will have to be approved by the supervisor(s) and the Academic Committee of the Department. Supervisor(s) are chosen by students and have to be approved by the Academic Committee.
